CHI Memorial Georgia Andrew McGill, Sr. VP /of Strategy, Business Development and Government Relations was introduced by Doris White as our speaker.

CHI Memorial - Georgia will build a new facility on Battlefield Pkwy with 64 beds, 20 ED Rooms, 5 Operating Suites with 90% of all surgeries being able to be done at this location. The hospital will be LED and SMART certified and have a helicopter pad. The new hospital design has been approved, and he noted a 20% increase in the cost of materials. Goal is to break ground in spring of 2022. The fund-raising goal in support of the new hospital is \$5 million dollars.

McGill encouraged everyone to get their COVID vaccine and now is the time for the Flu vaccine.

He promised to return for another meeting to show the design for the new hospital.
