The Athens Kiwanis Club will host the Kentucky-Tennessee District Governor's Visit for Divisions 3 and 4 on Saturday, November 15, 2025, at Tennessee Wesleyan University in Downtown Athens.

We will start at 11 a.m. with a service project for the Love Thy Neighbor Project, a food insecurity program led by Tennessee Wesleyan University staff and students. The program seeks to provide low-income individuals with healthy, fresh foods on a regular basis to alleviate the burden of food insecurity and encourage a healthy diet. In the past year, the TWU Campus Food Pantry served more than 2,500 clients; the Mobile Food Pantry provided food to 1,426 local households, and the Back Sacks program gives nutritional options for breakfast, lunch, snacks, and drinks to more than 250 students at six schools in the McMinn County.

Our project will be to help pack sacks for the Back Sacks project with various food items. This project can be done standing or sitting, so it should be a project in which people of all abilities can participate.

We will base the number of sacks on the number of attendees who RSVP, and we expect that project will take no more than an hour to complete.

Lunch will follow around noon in Tennessee Wesleyan's Glenn Lowe Dining Room, which is the room where the Athens Kiwanis Club holds its weekly meeting.
