Guest speaker was Tom Weldon, chairman of the Juvenile Justice committee and 8 year member of the House of Representatives. He spoke about the vote on Amendment 2 in the upcoming election entitled Safe Harbor or Rachel's Law. This amendment proposes to impose the greater of a 1% or \$5000 tax on all live adult entertainment venues to be placed into a fund dedicated to provide support for victims of human trafficking. The money will be used as funding for programs including safe houses, medical/social services, and drug rehabilitation services for rescued victims. It also serves to protect victims of human trafficking from being convicted of a sex crime.
