Senator Mullis sponsored and passed several bills. SB 77 which was monument protection. He also sponsored a bill for required recreation in schools. SB 83 expanded religious studies in public schools.

Some bills that the legislature passed that impact us include: income tax in 2019 and 2020, new election machines that add paper you confirm and then scan and paper kept for recounts, and medical marijuana to grow in Georgia. Hemp is also now legal to grow in Georgia, in past it was made illegal to promote nylon rope
