They introduced Anthony Dye, director of eth Children's Advocacy Center. He told about the center and they do medical and forensic interviews of children reporting abuse. They turn cases over to law enforcement after the interviews. in 2020 they had 260 reports.

Forensic interviews can be after a fire or fight also.

They did 68 medical exams in 2020. To date in 2021 they have had 125 forensic interviews.

They have therapy mental health services. He said we all need to do self care. He fishes to get away.

They work to spread awareness and prevention.

The money to run the center comes 50% from VCCA and rest is contributions. They will do a golf tournament on 9/16 at LaFayette golf course.

Their services are entirely free. They do not bill insurance or anyone.
