She spoke about the history and mission of LifeSpring which primarily serves children but hopes to expand to all ages.

Recently they moved from an old house to a modern medical facility. The house was where to pediatricians operated for about 60 years before LifeSpring.

They intend to serve the whole child. They also give Covid vaccines at various locations in Chattanooga (including in old office) and also go to shut-ins homes.

Last year they served over 2300 children patients. All patients receive the same care whether insured, Medicaid, uninsured, etc. They also work with community health workers to try to make home environments better.
