

## Kiwanis Club of Swainsboro, Georgia 2018-2019 Projects

Projects of the Kiwanis Club of Swainsboro from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019:

- 1. Kiwanis sponsors and financially supports Cub Scout Pack 75 and Troop 75.
- 2. Kiwanis sponsors and financially supports the Circle K at East Georgia State College (EGSC).
- 3. Kiwanis gives a legacy scholarship at EGSC.
- 4. Kiwanis times over 10 runs per year throughout middle Georgia.
- 5. Kiwanis provides over \$300 for the Kiwanis International Children's Fund.
- 6. Kiwanis provides a total of over \$400 for these Kiwanis Georgia District Projects: Auditory-Verbal Center's "Buck-n-Ear"; the Georgia District Art and Music Showcase; the Georgia District Kiwanis Foundation, Inc.; Georgia Kiwanis Student Leadership Program; and, Tomorrow's Leaders.
- 7. As part of the Fall Festival, Kiwanis and members of the Circle K at EGSC gave cotton candy, popcorn, and apples to over 1,000 children and adults.
- 8. Kiwanis partnered with Family Connection to read to Early Head Start students and give them a total of 96 books during the Book-O-Ween on October 31, 2018.
- 9. Kiwanis gave a contribution to Swainsboro Middle School to help fund students who participated in the International Festival in Statesboro. They came in 2<sup>nd</sup> place!
- 10. Kiwanis collected and gave over 120 cans of food and food items to the Food Bank in Swainsboro in November 2018.
- 11. Kiwanis gave over 30 bikes to needy kids at the Emanuel County Early Learning Center in Swainsboro. We gave over 70 more toys to DFCS, the Swainsboro Police Department, Goodwill, and the Jaycees/Swainsboro Fire Department who were collecting for Toys for Tots.
