Established in 1993, they have 15 clinical sites and include among their services adult medicine, pediatrics, women's health, mental health, chiropractic, optometry, chronic care, in-house pharmacy, dental, wellness, vaccines, school-based medicine, and community education. They also employ mobile units in the 5,800 sq. mile service area through their outreach program. They currently see over 25,000 patients each year with over 70,000 patient/healthcare provider interactions. They most recently opened an Optometry Clinic behind the N. Coleman St. building.
