The station is located in a mountainous region of Costa Rica surrounded by dense forest with many walking trails. The students and professors did a week-long study of the small animal population of the leaf litter on the forest floor, using a drift fence to collect mice, snakes, frogs, scorpions, spiders, and other insects to assess the forest 40 to 50 years after logging was ceased in the area. They also had some free time to visit a local coffee plantation and see the countryside. It was a great experience since this was the 1st time the students had been in Latin America. Costa Rica is a very interesting country with no standing army and an aggressive environmental program. Great coffee also!
